



## Membership of Fife Folk Museum Trust

Members of the trust contribute to fund-raising initiatives, volunteering and other activities. Membership provides a quarterly newsletter, free entry to the Museum on production of the membership card and a 10% discount on purchases in the Museum gift shop.

Membership subscriptions are currently:

**Annual Member £10.00 minimum**

**Life Member £100 minimum**

Payments can be made by cheque or standing order. On receipt of your completed application form and payment, you should receive your membership pack within 28 days.

**Paying your membership subscription by standing order helps reduce our administration costs.** For members paying by standing order you should receive your membership pack within 14 days of the Trustees receiving confirmation of your standing order payment reaching our bank account.

We would strongly encourage you to complete a **Gift Aid** form if you are a UK income or capital gains tax payer. This allows us to claim addition funding from HM Revenue and Customs.

This transitional relief for the museum does not affect your personal tax position. If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you wish to receive the additional tax relief due to you. Fife Folk Museum Trust will use this information only for claiming Gift Aid. To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in UK income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim in the tax year.
